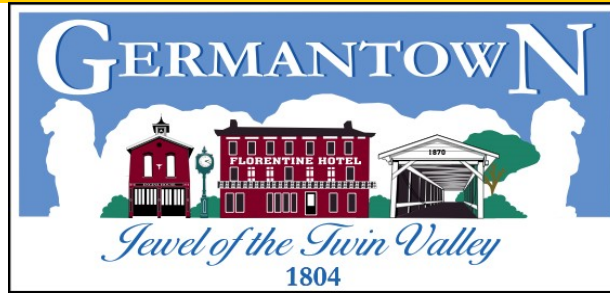

## Leaf Collection 2020

Leaf collection is provided to all the Germantown residents who live adjacent to a public roadway. The City will collect leaves mid-October thru mid-December, weather permitting. Please rake your leaves to the edge of your property in an open area where they are accessible to the crews, not behind parked cars, mail boxes, trees, shrubs, etc. The Street Department will be collecting leaves daily. Leaves will not be picked up on holidays. Leaf collection does allow for scheduled areas, streets, or specific times, but we make every attempt to service the entire town. The City will continue to allow residents to bring leaves to the Service Department located at 148 S. Water Street between the hours of 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Monday–Friday. Please place leaves in the designated area. Bagged leaves must be emptied and the bags taken with you. Brush **will not** be accepted.
